## Eurobodalla Natural History Society Program of Field Meetings February to July 2021

Field trips are held on the second Saturday and fourth (sometimes fifth) Sunday of the month from February to November. Walks are generally of an easy grade. Saturday meetings begin at 2pm and finish around 4.30pm. Sunday meetings begin at 9am and finish at lunchtime, so we suggest that you bring along lunch and a chair.

Saturday 13 February, 2pm	Cullendulla Creek Meet at the car park off Myamba Parade, which is almost opposite Wallarah Street, Surfside.	A walk along the beach to the boardwalk that takes you through the mangroves along the creek. Pied and Sooty Oystercatcher, Gull-billed Tern, White- bellied Sea-Eagle, Southern Emu-wren, Mistletoebird.
Sunday 28 February, 9am	Wallaga Lake, Long Swamp Turn east off Princes Hwy into Bermagui Rd south of Tilba, continue until the single lane bridge over the lake. Cross the bridge, and after 1km, turn left into Wallaga Street. Meet at the parking area at the end of the street.	A beach and headland walk. Hooded, Double-banded and Red-capped Plover, Pied and Sooty Oystercatcher, Eastern Curlew, Bar-tailed Godwit. The area is also a favourite for several raptor species, including Black-shouldered Kite and White-bellied Sea-Eagle. Musk Duck, cormorants, egrets and Black Swan at the swamp.
Saturday 13 March, 2pm	<b>Tebbs Road and Pipparidge</b> Meet at the Narooma Visitors' Centre on the Princes Hwy. We will proceed to Tebbs Road via the Old Highway. Car- pooling is recommended.	Drive and stop to walk along several tracks through the forest. Superb Lyrebird, Green Catbird, Scarlet Robin, Spotted Quail-Thrush, Crescent Honeyeater. Pipparidge is the property of our members, John and Meg Gordon. Rufous Fantail, Green Catbird, many species of honeyeater, Gang-gang Cockatoo, Superb Lyrebird and Brown Cuckoo-Dove.

Saturday 10 April, 2pm	<b>Bingie Dreaming Track (Bingie/Coila)</b> Meet at the Princes Hwy and Bingie Rd junction.	Coastal forest and lakeside walk. Rufous Fantail, Scarlet Honeyeater, Common Cicadabird, Brown Gerygone, Eastern Shrike-tit and a variety of water and shore birds on the lake.

Sunday 25July, 9am	<b>Pedro Swamp</b> Meet at the car park outside the Eurobodalla Shire Council and the Library, off Vulcan Street, Moruya.	A visit to private property with access to Pedro Swamp. We will walk through Spotted Gum forest to the swamp. Glossy Black-Cockatoo, Red-browed Treecreeper, White-eared Honeyeater, Fuscous Honeyeater, Musk Duck, Swamp Harrier.
