

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INTRODUCTION

It is a pleasure to introduce this twenty ninth edition of *Nature in Eurobodalla*, a report on the status of the fauna of the Eurobodalla Shire compiled from records submitted to the Eurobodalla Natural History Society during 2014. A map of the Shire is reproduced inside the front cover and a list of place name abbreviations used in the text appears inside the back cover.

In 2014 NSW experienced its warmest year on record, with several heatwaves and many places across the State breaking temperature records during January and November. In the Eurobodalla temperatures did not reach the record highs of 2013 but the Shire did experience an exceptionally prolonged warm spell in autumn and the warmest spring maximum temperatures on record. Rainfall across the Shire was significantly higher than the long term average, with the official stations at Batemans Bay, Dalmeny, Moruya Heads and Narooma all recording around 1100mm for the year, with over half of this falling on the seven wettest days. March, August and December were particularly wet with 240-260mm in each of these months, whilst July was the driest month with only 2mm recorded my gauge at Bergalia.

The year produced sightings of a number of rare and unusual species; in March a Cook's Petrel was found near Moruya, in May a small flock of Plumed Whistling-Duck were photographed near Moruya and in December a group of 5 Red-necked Avocet were photographed at Tuross, all firsts for the Shire. A number of species which had not been recorded for several years also turned up. These included Freckled Duck at Comerang, Red-tailed Tropicbird at Montagu Island, Little Shearwater at Tuross and Moruya Heads, Terek Sandpiper at Tuross, Noisy Pitta at Wallaga Lake and Gulaga, Blue-faced Honeyeater at Guerilla Bay, Little Friarbird at Tuross and Coolagolite and Pink Robin at Box Cutting. The reptiles included a Tiger Snake at Moruya and a Common Death Adder at the Deua River, the first since 1997. The Eastern Sedgefrog also appears to continue to expand its range since the first record in 2011, with sightings at Bevian Rd, Lilli Pilli and Mogo.

The absence of sightings can sometimes be as interesting as their presence. In 2014 there were no reports of White-fronted Tern, the first

time since 1986 that this winter migrant has been absent from the records. Whether the species failed to make its usual migration to our coast from New Zealand for some reason, or whether it was simply overlooked by observers is not possible to say.

During the year members of the Society again participated in the BirdLife Australia surveys for Swift Parrot and shorebirds and the NSW Parks and Wildlife shorebird monitoring programs. These activities provided additional records from the forested areas in the west of the Shire and from the coastal strip than have generally been available in recent years. An off-shore field trip from Narooma to Montagu Island and beyond in October also added records of a number of seabirds, to complement those from land-based observations.

The report is restricted to those species recorded during the year; species not recorded are not listed. An annotated list of all bird species recorded in the Eurobodalla since the inception of the Society in 1986 is available on the Society's website (www.enhs.org.au) and is updated annually to reflect new sightings. As noted in previous years, the records reflect the distribution of observers and their interests as much as the distribution of the fauna. However, despite these shortcomings the records continue to provide a valuable qualitative assessment of the status of species in the Shire, enabling trends over the years to be evaluated.

As in other recent years, the vertebrate taxonomic sequence basically follows Clayton *et al* (2006), with the listing of birds following the BirdLife Australia checklist based on Christides and Boles (2008). Taxonomic references used in compiling this report are listed below.

Once again, my thanks go out to all contributors who have made this report possible. In particular I would like to thank my co-complier, Julie Morgan, for her work as the Society's Recorder during the year. Thanks also to Chris Davey *et al* for the 56th Annual Assessment of Shearwater Breeding on Montagu Island. A complete list of those who have contributed their observations during the year appears on the final page.

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BIRDS

CASUARIIDAE Emu

Emu Dromaius novaehollandiae

Status: introduced in 1993, small wild population established.

Five at TS estuary on 24 Feb, 4 on 23 Jul; 2 at PP in Jun, at Bodalla in Aug; 1 at Brou L in Jun; tracks at TS in Nov, at Tarourga L in Dec.

PHASIANIDAE Quail, pheasants.

Stubble Quail Coturnix pectoralis

Status: uncommon breeding resident.

Twenty at Com in Jan-Feb and Jun, 10 in other months. (JC)

Brown Quail Coturnix ypsilophora

Status: uncommon breeding resident.

Up to 18 at Montagu Is on 24-28 Mar, 12 in Oct; 10 at OMBS in Jan;

calls at Com in Jan-Apr and Jun.

Breeding: juveniles on Montagu Is in Mar. (MC)

ANATIDAE Swan, ducks

Plumed Whistling-Duck Dendrocygna eytoni

Status: vagrant.

A flock of 10 photographed at Noads Drive Moruya in May, first record for the Shire. (R Grant/MC)

Musk Duck Biziura lobata

Status: uncommon breeding resident.

Eight at Nelligen on 16 May; 5 at PS in Feb, at Deua R in Aug; 2 at MO in Oct; singles at OMBS in May, at PS in Aug and Nov, at Tarourga L in Nov.

Breeding: dependent young at PS in Feb, juvenile at Tarourga L in Oct. (JM/DB)

Freckled Duck Stictonetta naevosa

Status: Vulnerable (NSW Schedule 2); vagrant.

Five to eight at Com in Oct-Nov, first record since 2005. (JC)

Black Swan Cygnus atratus

Status: common breeding resident and bird of passage.

Widely reported throughout the year; up to 1500 at Tarourga L in Nov; 300 at Brou L in Feb, 150 in Jun; 192 at WL in Feb, 120 in Mar, 100 in Jul; 150 at MB in Mar and Dec, at Barlings Swamp in Mar; 100 at OMBS in Mar; 50 at Long Swamp in Mar; less than 50 at other

locations.

Breeding: nesting in Oct, cygnets in Jan-Mar and Jul.

Australian Shelduck Tadorna tadornoides

Status: vagrant.

Four at Brou L on 13 Nov; 2 at Com on 23 Nov, 1 on 18 Oct; 1 at

Tarourga L on 13 Nov. (DB/JC)

Australian Wood Duck Chenonetta jubata

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely reported throughout the year; 100 at Com in May-Jul, Sep and Dec, 50-80 in other months; 90 at Eurobodalla Rd in Feb; 60 at MYA in May and Aug, 10-40 in other months; 50 at Runnyford Rd in Jun; no more than 40 at other locations.

Breeding: dependent young in Feb, Sep-Dec.

Pink-eared Duck Malacorhynchus membranaceus

Status: vagrant.

Up to 130 at Com in Nov-Dec, 27 in Oct, 2 in Aug; 45 at Coila L in Nov; 8 at OMBS in Mar; 5 at Trunketabella in Nov, 2 in Feb-Mar; 2 at Tarourga L in Dec.

Australasian Shoveler Anas rhynchotis

Status: uncommon winter migrant, has bred.

Up to 100 at OMBS on 8 Mar; 20 at Tarourga L in Nov, 8 in Dec; 20 at Barlings Swamp in Mar, at Coila L in Nov; 8 at Com in Nov-Dec, 3-4 in Sep-Oct; 2 at Trunketabella in Feb.

Grey Teal Anas gracilis

Status: breeding resident.

Reported throughout the year; 700 at Tarourga L in Nov, 600 in Dec; 650 at OMBS in Mar; 350 at Barlings Swamp in Mar; 50 at Brou L in Jun, at Com in Jun-Jul and Dec; no more than 40 at other locations. Breeding: dependent young at Com in Oct. (JC)

Chestnut Teal Anas castanea

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely reported throughout the year; 1300 at Tarourga L in Nov, 600 in Dec; 1000 at Barlings Swamp in Mar; 650 at OMBS in Mar; 300 at Com in Jun-Jul, 100 in Apr-May, Aug-Oct and Dec; 100 at Brou L and Eurobodalla Rd in Jun; less than 100 at other locations.

Breeding: nesting at Com in Aug, dependent young at PS in Jan and

Com in Nov. (JC/JM)

Pacific Black Duck Anas superciliosa

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely reported throughout the year; 650 at OMBS in Mar; 500 at Tarourga L in Nov, 100 in Dec; 350 at Barlings Swamp in Mar; 300 at Com in Jun-Jul, 50-200 in other months; 60 at Eurobodalla Rd in Jun; less than 50 at other locations.

Breeding: nesting at Com in Aug. (JC)

Hardhead Aythya australis

Status: common resident and bird of passage.

Up to 100 at Tarourga L in Nov-Dec; 75 at BI in Feb; 50 at Trunketabella in Sep, 20 in Nov; 33 at Com in Oct, 20 in Nov-Dec; no more than 10 at other locations.

PHAETHONTIDAE Tropicbirds

Red-tailed Tropicbird Phaethon rubicund

Status: Vulnerable (NSW Schedule 2); vagrant

One adult and 1 juvenile reported at Montagu Is in Mar, first record since 2005. (DB)

PODICIPEDIDAE Grebes

Australasian Grebe Tachybaptus novaehollandiae

Status: common breeding resident.

Sixty at TS in Jun; 27 at Eurobodalla Rd in Apr, 21 in Jul, 20 in Jun; 22 at Barlings Swamp in Mar; 12 at MB in Jul, 10 in Feb and Aug; 11 at PS in Mar; 10 at Brou L in Jan; fewer than 10 at other locations.

Hoary-headed Grebe Poliocephalus poliocephalus

Status: breeding resident.

More than 100 at Brou L in Jun; 60 at Barlings Swamp in Mar; 50 at Tarourga L in Dec; 30 at Long Swamp in Mar; 20 at Com in Dec, 12 in Nov; fewer than 10 at other locations.

Breeding: dependent young at Com in Oct-Dec. (JC)

COLUMBIDAE Pigeons, doves

Rock Dove Columba livia

Status: common breeding resident.

Established colonies at BB, MYA and NA; reported maxima: 40 at NA in Apr and Dec; 18 at MYA in Sep; 10 at BB in Nov.

White-headed Pigeon Columba leucomela

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely recorded in all months; 32 at WL in Jul; 21 at MKS in Oct, 20 in Mar; 12 at TS in May; 6 at BI in Apr; no more than 5 at other locations. Breeding: nesting at WL in Mar, juveniles at BP in Feb and Dec, at MB in Apr. (MA/JW)

Spotted Dove *Streptopelia chinensis*

Status: breeding resident.

Ten at MYA in May, 1-3 most other months; 6 at MB in Mar, May and Nov, 2-4 most other months; 3 at BI in Feb; 2 at PDD in Feb; calls at WL in Mar, at BP in Dec.

Brown Cuckoo-Dove Macropygia amboinensis

Status: uncommon breeding resident and bird of passage.

Twelve at NA in Feb; 10 at MKS in Jun, 9 in Jul-Aug; 4 at Coolagolite in Sep, 2 in Jul; 2 at Deua R in Nov; singles at TS in Feb, at Coman's Mine in Apr, at Akolele in Jul, at Malua Bay and at MO in Sep.

Emerald Dove Chalcophaps indica

Status: vagrant.

One recorded at MB on 22 Jan. (MA)

Common Bronzewing Phaps chalcoptera

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely recorded in all months, 1-4 at most locations; up to 12 at MKS in Jan and March; 10 at PS in Nov, at Deua R in Dec; 9 at Com in Mar-May; 6 at Bergalia in Apr, at Brou L and Eurobodalla Rd in Jun; no more than 4 at other locations.

Breeding: nesting at MKS in Aug-Sep; at Mossy Pt in Sep and at Com in Sep-Oct. (SMG/HR/JC)

Brush Bronzewing *Phaps elegans*

Status: uncommon breeding resident.

Single birds recorded at Bodalla on 20 Jan, at Kianga Forest Rd on 8 Feb and at Eurobodalla Rd on 18 Apr. (MA/FM/NC)

Crested Pigeon Ocyphaps lophotes

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely recorded in all months; 30 at BI in Feb; 12 at Com in Apr-May, 8-10 in other months; 10 at MB in Jun-Jul; 8 at TS in Apr, 7 in Mar and May; 6 at MYA in Jun; 5 at Bergalia in Mar, at MO in Aug-Sep; no

more than 4 at other locations.

Breeding: nesting at Com in Nov, dependent young in Jan and Dec. (JC)

Peaceful Dove Geopelia striata

Status: breeding resident but becoming less common.

Five at Com on 2 Apr, calls in Feb. (JC)

Bar-shouldered Dove *Geopelia humeralis*

Status: uncommon resident.

Six at Montagu Is on 30 Mar; 6 at Surfside in Apr, 2-3 in Feb-Mar, Jun and Dec; 3 at BP in Mar and Jul, 1-2 most other months; 1 at Com in Dec. (DB/JC/JW/MC)

Wonga Pigeon Leucosarcia picata

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely recorded in all months, 1-2 or calls at most locations; 15 at Belowra Rd in Oct; 6 at MKS in Jan, at NA in Feb, at Eurobodalla Rd in Jun; 4 at MB in Jan, Mar, May and Jul-Sep, at Com in Sep; no more than 3 at other locations.

Breeding: juvenile at TS in Feb. (JH)

Topknot Pigeon Lopholaimus antarcticus

Status: bird of passage.

Fifty at MO in Nov; 20 at PS in Nov; 13 at MKS in Dec, 3 in Jun; 12 at Mullimburra Pt in Nov;10 at Malua Bay in Oct and Dec; 8 at PP in Nov; 2 at NA in Aug.

PODARGIDAE Frogmouths

Tawny Frogmouth Podargus strigoides

Status: breeding resident.

Four at Deua R in Sep-Oct, 1-2 most other months; 4 at TS in Nov, 1-3 in other months; 2 at Com in May, at MO in Sep; 1 at Bergalia in Jan and Apr, at Coolagolite in Apr-May and Oct, at PS and MB in Jun, at BP in Oct-Nov and at Bevian Rd in Dec; calls at MKS in Jan-Feb, Aug and Nov.

Breeding: juveniles at TS in Jan and Nov. (JH)

EUROSTOPODIDAE Nightjars

White-throated Nightjar Eurostopodus mystacalis

Status: summer breeding migrant.

Three at PS in Dec, 2 in Oct-Nov, calls in Jan-Feb; 2 at Deua R in Mar, calls in Sep and Nov; 1 at MKS in Dec, calls in Nov; calls at Coolagolite

in Dec. (JM/MS/SMG/S Sass)

AEGOTHELIDAE Owlet-nightjars

Australian Owlet-nightjar Aegotheles cristatus

Status: breeding resident.

One at Com in all months; 1 at PS in Aug; calls at MKS in Jan and Sep. (JC/JM/SMG)

APODIDAE Swifts

White-throated Needletail Hirundapus caudacutus

Status: summer migrant.

Widely reported Jan-Mar and Nov-Dec; 250 at Com on 16 Feb, 150 in Mar and Nov; 100 at Eurobodalla Rd in Feb; 80 at PP in Nov; 40 at MKS in Jan, at Nangudga L in Feb, at Surfside in Mar; no more than 30 at other locations; last record at MKS on 16 Mar, first return at PS on 26 Oct.

OCEANITIDAE Storm Petrels

White-faced Storm-Petrel Pelagodroma marina

Status: summer breeding migrant.

An estimated 50 pairs breeding at Montagu Is in Mar. (MC)

DIOMEDEIDAE Albatrosses

Black-browed Albatross Thalassarche melanophris

Status: Vulnerable (NSW Schedule 2); common winter pelagic.

Twenty at DS on 27 Jul; 9 at Montagu Is on 27 Mar; 4 off NA in Oct; 4 off CO in Aug, 3 in Jun; 1 off MO in Aug.

Shy Albatross Thalassarche cauta

Status: Vulnerable (NSW Schedule 2); common winter pelagic.

Six off Montagu Is in Mar; 2 off CO in Aug, off NA in Oct; 1 beachcast at MHS in Jan.

Yellow-nosed Albatross Thalassarche chlororhynchos

Status: common winter pelagic.

Three off Montagu Is in Mar; 1 off DS in Jun. (MC/FM)

PROCELLARIIDAE Petrels, shearwaters

Cape Petrel Daption capense

Status: common pelagic.

One recorded off NA on 7 Feb. (AH)

Shearwater sp.

Hundreds off MHS in Jan-Feb; 20 off Brou L in Feb; 10 off MB in Feb; large numbers beachcast from BP to MB in Nov-Dec.

Wedge-tailed Shearwater Ardenna pacifica

Status: common breeding resident and summer migrant.

Large numbers off Montagu Is in Mar; 100 off NA on 19 Oct. (MC/FM)

Breeding: chicks at Montagu Is 24-28 Mar. (MC)

Flesh-footed Shearwater Ardenna carneipes

Status: Vulnerable (NSW Schedule 2); summer migrant

Twelve off NA on 7 Feb. (AH)

Sooty Shearwater Ardenna grisea

Status: summer migrant, breeding on Montagu Is. One chick banded at Montagu Is on 28 Mar. (MC)

Short-tailed Shearwater *Ardenna tenuirostris*

Status: common summer breeding migrant.

Thousands off NA in Oct; small numbers off Montagu Is in Mar; small numbers beachcast at BP in Oct, at MHS and TS in Nov.

Breeding: chicks at Montagu Is 24-28 Mar. (MC)

Fluttering Shearwater Puffinus gavia

Status: common pelagic.

Three off Montagu Is on 24 Mar, off NA on 19 Oct. (MC/FM)

Little Shearwater Puffinus assimilis

Status: Vulnerable (NSW Schedule 2); vagrant.

Single birds beachcast at TS on 23 Nov and at MHS on 24 Nov. (FM/JM)

Gould's Petrel Pterodroma leucoptera

Status: Vulnerable (NSW Schedule 2); uncommon pelagic, breeding at Montagu Is.

Four adults with 2 chicks at Montagu Is in Feb, both chicks banded in Mar. (AH/MC)

Cook's Petrel Pterodroma cookie

Status: vagrant.

One found in a distressed state at MYA on 27 Mar but died overnight. Identification confirmed by NSW NPWS and the Australian Museum, where it was lodged as a voucher specimen. (N Riches/MC)

SPHENISCIDAE Penguins

Little Penguin Eudyptula minor

Status: common breeding resident.

A number moulting in nest boxes at Montagu Is in Mar; one chick in nest box at Montagu Is in Oct; one beachcast at MB in Mar and Jul. Breeding: chick at Montagu Is in Oct. (FM)

SULIDAE Gannets, boobies.

Australasian Gannet Morus serrator

Status: common winter migrant and bird of passage. Fifty off CO in Jun, off DS in Jul; 25 off NA in Oct; 10 off MHS,

Mullimburra Pt and Bingie in Apr, off MB in May, off Brou L in Jun, off BP in Aug; no more than 6 at other locations.

ANHINGIDAE Darter

Australasian Darter Anhinga novaehollandiae

Status: breeding resident.

Four at OMBS on 8 Mar; 3 at Coila L in Sep; 2 at Catalina and TS in May; singles at Com in most months, at TS in Feb, at NA in Mar and Jul and at MHS in Aug.

PHALACROCORACIDAE Cormorants

Little Pied Cormorant Microcarbo melanoleucos

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely reported in all months; 50 at WL in Feb and Jun, 30 in Sep, 20 in Mar and Dec; 50 at TS in Apr; 30 at Brou L in Feb, at MB in Jun; 25 at NA in Oct; 24 at MHS in Aug; 20 at Long Swamp in Mar, at Montagu Is in Oct; no more than 15 at other locations.

Great Cormorant Phalacrocorax carbo

Status: common resident.

Widely reported in all months; 150 at MB in Jun, 10 -35 most other months; 100 at WL in Mar, 40 in Feb; 60 at BI in Jan; 50 at Montagu Is in Oct; 43 at Nangudga L in Feb; 35 at MO in Oct; 30 at Long Swamp; no more than 25 at other locations.

Little Black Cormorant Phalacrocorax sulcirostris

Status: common resident.

Widely reported in all months; 200 at TS in May, 100 in Jan-Mar and Jul; 100 at Tarourga L in Nov, 50 in Dec; 50 at Com in Sep, at Montagu Is and NA in Oct; 40 at WL in Feb; 28 at Nangudga L in Feb; no more than 20 at other locations.

Pied Cormorant *Phalacrocorax varius*

Status: uncommon resident.

Nine at TS on 24 Feb, 8 in Nov; 6 at MB in Apr, at Brou L in Jun; 5 at MO in Aug, 4 in Nov; 4 at Catalina in May, at NA in Oct; no more than 3 at other locations.

PELECANIDAE Pelican

Australian Pelican Pelecanus conspicillatus

Status: common resident.

Widely reported in all months; 80 at Nangudga L on 11 Feb; 57 at TS in Mar, 25-30 most other months; 35 overflying Bergalia in Feb, at Tarourga L in Nov; 30 at WL in Jun; no more than 25 at other locations.

ARDEIDAE Bitterns, herons, egrets

White-necked Heron Ardea pacifica

Status: breeding resident.

Ten at Com in Feb, 7 in Jun, 2-6 in other months; 8 at Trunketabella in Jan; 8 at MYA in Sep, 1-4 most other months; 4 at Eurobodalla Rd in Jun; 1-3 at many locations.

Breeding: nest building at Com in Aug, juvenile at MYA in Jun. (JC/JM)

Eastern Great Egret Ardea modesta

Status: common resident.

Widely recorded in all months, mostly singles; 20 at Tarourga L on 13 Nov, 8 in Dec; 15 at Nangudga L and Trunketabella in Feb; 10 at WL in Feb; 9 at MHN in Dec, 7 in Aug; 6 at MYA in May; 5 at TS in Feb; no more than 4 at other locations

Intermediate Egret Ardea intermedia

Status: uncommon migrant.

Single birds recorded at Com in Mar-Oct, at PS in Mar-Apr, at OMBS in Mar, at Catalina in May and at MB in Sep.

Cattle Egret Ardea ibis

Status: common autumn-spring migrant.

Recorded Mar-Nov; 70 at Coila L on 3 Nov; 35 at MYA in Sep, 30 in May, 20 in Apr and Jul; 25 at Bergalia in Apr; 20 at Bodalla in Apr; 16 at Com in Mar, at TS in May; fewer than 15 at other locations.

Striated Heron Butorides striata

Status: uncommon breeding resident.

Two at TS in Mar, 1 in Feb; 2 at MHS in Aug; 1 at NA in Feb.

White-faced Heron Egretta novaehollandiae

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely reported in all months; 40 at BI in Feb; 36 at Nangudga L in Feb; 25 at Com in Dec, 8-15 in other months; 24 at WL in Feb, 14 in Mar; 18 at TS in Feb; 16 at Barlings Swamp in Mar; 12 at NA in Feb, at Eurobodalla Rd in Jun; 11 at MYA in Nov; no more than 10 at other locations.

Breeding: nesting at Com in Aug-Oct and Dec, dependent young at Malua Bay in Dec. (JC/MW)

Little Egret Egretta garzetta

Status: common resident.

Over 200 at MYA in Jun, 50 in May, 20-30 in Jul-Sep; 45 at Nangudga L in Feb; 11 at NA in Feb, 10 in Oct; 8 at MB in Jun; 6 at TS in Feb, at WL in Jun; no more than 4 at other locations.

Eastern Reef Egret Egretta sacra

Status: resident.

Three at WL in Dec; 2 at MB in May, Jul-Aug, Oct-Dec, 1 in most other months; singles at BP in Jan, Mar and Dec, at Bingie in Jan and Apr, at CO and Mullimburra Pt in Jun, at Pedro Pt in Aug and at MO in Nov.

Nankeen Night Heron Nycticorax caledonicus

Status: uncommon breeding resident.

Three at NA in Oct; 3 Com in Jan-Feb, 2 in Aug-Dec; 2 at ERBG in Feb, 1 at MKS in Nov.

THRESKIORNITHIDAE Ibises, spoonbills

Australian White Ibis Threskiornis molucca

Status: common resident and winter-spring migrant.

56th ANNUAL ASSESSMENT OF SHEARWATER BREEDING SUCCESS ON MONTAGU ISLAND, 23–30 MARCH 2015

Chris Davey, Mike Crowley, Peter J. Fullagar and David Priddel

The format of this report and the abbreviations used are consistent with those in previous annual reports (e.g. Crowley *et al.* 2014). The study site on the SE side of the smaller northern part of Montagu Island is known as NISA (293 m²); the two study sites at the northern end of the southern part are known as SISA (428 m²) and THISA (293 m²). The bird records for the island have been reviewed by Fullagar (1989) but many subsequent records have been included in annual reports (similar to this one) dating back to 1998. Names and taxonomic order of birds follow Christidis and Boles (2008); all other vertebrates follow Clayton *et al.* (2006). Names of butterflies follow Braby (2004) and moths follow Common (1990) while those of vascular plants follow those used by Heyligers and Adams (1989, 2004).

Survey Team

This year's team comprised Peter Fullagar, Mike Crowley and Chris Davey (MIPartners); David and Lesley Priddel, Vanessa Place, Paula Pollock and Penny Beaver.

Weather and Habitat Conditions

We departed Narooma at 09:15 on 23 March, crossing to the island in very rough conditions on a confused sea with a strong N wind. The day continued overcast with strong wind. On 24 March it rained with a southerly gale force wind. On 25 March it was overcast with light southerly winds all day and no rain. It was clear with high cloud and light SW winds on 26 March. Fine weather with sunny and light winds continued for the rest of our stay. We returned to Narooma at noon on 30 March under calm conditions.

Rainfall figures (mm) for the period April 2014 to March 2015 are as follows: 89.4, 25.0, 92.2, 0.6, 108.4, 87.4, 85.6, 36.8, 126.0, 144.8, 21.6, 31.2.

The condition of the vegetation was different from that of last year. The Spiny-headed Mat-rush *Lomandra longifolia* was in very good condition, lush and dense on all study plots. Intrusion of Scarlet Runner *Kennedia rubicunda* continues on SISA and on NISA, and Kikuyu Grass

Pennisetum clandestinum continues its spread on SISA along both the N and S borders. Few other plants were noted on any study plot and only one Kangaroo Apple Solanum vescum was found on SISA. However, Bracken Pteridium esculentum on SISA was mostly thick and lush on the S side.

Coverage

We started work on THISA at 13:05 on 23 March and finished by 16:00. On 24 March no work was possible because of strong southerly gales and rain. Work started on NISA at 08:50 on 25 March and finished at 15:10. On 26 March we started on SISA at 08:55 working until 13:30. We then continued at 14:30 finishing at 16:36. A film crew was present during the late morning.

On 27 March we surveyed the perimeter of south island. On 28 March north island was covered by Chris Davey and David Priddel while Peter Fullagar and Mike Crowley surveyed south island. On this day we particularly concentrated on completing our counts of seals and Sooty Oystercatchers. On 29 and 30 March observations were confined to bird counts around the lightstation.

Survey Results

The results of this year's survey, together with those for 2014, are summarised in Table 1.

For Wedge-tailed Shearwater the total number of chicks found was slightly higher than last year but not as high as the peak year of 2013. On THISA, however, the number of Wedge-tailed Shearwater chicks was close to the 24-year average of 10.

Short-tailed Shearwaters had recovered to some extent from the low productivity seen in 2014 but chick numbers remained low, approximately 50% of the numbers found in most years of the past decade.

As Table 1 shows, more burrows were found on the plots than in 2014. The overall percentage of occupied burrows also increased but was still lower than the percentage often seen in the past.

The average weight of Wedge-tailed Shearwater chicks this season was 537g (304–712g); the comparable figure for Short-tailed Shearwater was 724g (420–962g). Both of these figures indicate that chicks were in good condition; however, the Wedge-tails were slightly heavier than last year and the Short-tails slightly lighter.

General Observations of Birds, Mammals, Reptiles and Lepidoptera BIRDS

Thirty-nine species were recorded this year and eleven eBird (http://ebird.org/content/ebird/about/) lists were submitted.

Brown Quail *Coturnix ypsilophora*. Numerous on all parts of the island. Coveys of up to eight birds seen in various places included juveniles.

Bar-shouldered Dove *Geopelia humeralis*. Seen most days with maximum of four on 24 March.

White-throated Needletail *Hirundapus caudacutus*. One seen flying S over the lightstation into a southerly gale on 24 March and another around the lightstation on 30 March.

White-faced Storm-Petrel *Pelagodroma marina*. The small colony recently discovered in dense Coastal Saltbush *Rhagodia candolleana* on the S edge of north island continues to spread. This patch of Coastal Saltbush also continues spreading and becoming denser and taller. We did not examine any burrows and no birds were seen over the colony during a brief watch after dark on 27 March.

Black-browed Albatross *Thalassarche melanophrys*. One adult seen on 24 March during strong southerly conditions.

Shy Albatross *Thalassarche cauta*. One on 24 March and five on 27 March, all adults.

Yellow-nosed Albatross (Indian) *Thalassarche carteri*. One adult seen on 24 March.

Wedge-tailed Shearwater *Ardenna pacifica* and **Short-tailed Shearwater** *A. tenuirostris*. See Table 1 for this year's chick count. Both species seen in small numbers every day with several rafts NE of the island on 24 March.

Gould's Petrel *Pterodroma leucoptera*. A well-feathered chick in a burrow where two adults were discovered ashore in October 2012. Four other known nests present this year.

Little Penguin *Eudyptula minor*. Very little activity and no calling heard at night. Observations limited to one bird ashore on 26 March.

Australasian Gannet *Morus serrator*. A few observed at sea most days. **Great Cormorant** *Phalacrocorax carbo*. Seen daily with maximum of 25 roosting on rocks on W side of south island.

Little Black Cormorant *Phalacrocorax sulcirostris*. One seen on rocks near south landing 29 March.

Pied Cormorant *Phalacrocorax varius*. One north island on 28 March. **White-faced Heron** *Egretta novaehollandiae*. Three seen most days on south island.

Eastern Reef Egret *Egretta sacra*. One seen on south island on 24 and 27 March and presumably the same bird on north island 28 March.

White-bellied Sea-Eagle *Haliaeetus leucogaster*. Two adults, one sub-adult and one immature seen daily. Interaction between the adult birds and the sub-adult seen several times.

Swamp Harrier *Circus approximans*. Two seen. One pale bird with conspicuous white rump patch seen most days. Another very dark individual seen over south island on 28 March and again on 30 March. **Nankeen Kestrel** *Falco cenchroides*. A chestnut-crowned adult female seen on all days.

Peregrine Falcon *Falco peregrinus*. A pair or a single bird observed daily. No young present.

Buff-banded Rail *Gallirallus philippensis*. Few birds seen on south island. None found on north island. Predation of a first year bird (pointed primaries) on track to S end of the island on 28 March. **Sooty Oystercatcher** *Haematopus fuliginosus*. Maximum count of nine on south island and three on north island. We found three pairs on E side of south island, a single bird at the S end of south island and a pair at south landing most days. Three seen on north island on 28 March.

Caspian Tern *Hydroprogne caspia*. Maximum count of four birds seen most days.

Crested Tern *Thalasseus bergii*. Seen daily, with up to 60 on 28 March. **Silver Gull** *Chroicocephalus novaehollandiae*. Seen daily. Up to 80 present, mainly near the seals or at sea.

Yellow-faced Honeyeater *Lichenostomus chrysops*. Seen daily with a maximum of 30 mainly in thickets on SW and W side of south island.

Black-faced Cuckoo-shrike *Coracina novaehollandiae*. One seen on 28 March on south island.

Golden Whistler *Pachycephala pectoralis*. One female and one juvenile seen or heard most days in thicket area on W side of south island and just N of the lightstation.

Rufous Whistler *Pachycephala rufiventris*. One female on 27 March in Acacia thicket W side of south island.

Grey Fantail *Rhipidura albiscapa*. One seen on 24 March and again on 29 March. Twelve (on passage?) seen on 28 March. All observations in Acacia thickets.

Australian Raven *Corvus coronoides*. Two seen most days on south island and on north island on 28 March.

Scarlet Robin *Petroica boodang*. One female or immature seen around lightstation on 29 and 30 March.

Golden-headed Cisticola *Cisticola exilis*. Not vocal and difficult to detect, but a few seen on some days.

Australian Reed-Warbler *Acrocephalus australis*. One seen on 28 March on north island on headland just S of Pebbly Beach.

Little Grassbird *Megalurus gramineus*. Inconspicuous at this time of year. A few seen in Acacia thickets and calls heard on some days.

Silvereye *Zosterops lateralis*. Present on all days, mostly in the thickets along the W side of south island. Passage noted most days. Numbers not possible to assess.

Welcome Swallow *Hirundo neoxena*. Present daily throughout both islands. Maximum numbers estimated at 30 on 28 March.

Australasian Pipit *Anthus novaeseelandiae*. Two sightings on 28 March: one on north island and one on south island. Possibly the same bird.

MAMMALS

Seals. A count on 28 March gave six on the SW side of south island. On north island they were concentrated on the headland S of Pebbly Beach

(19 including three suckling pups) and in the NW (84), giving a total of 109. Most were thought to be **Australian Fur Seal** *A. pusillus*. The few seals on south island and a small number with pups on the S side of the headland near Pebbly Beach were **New Zealand Fur Seal** *Arctocephalus forsteri*.

REPTILES

White's Skink *Ergenia whitii*. Observed occasionally. Grass Sun-skink *Lampropholis guichenoti*. Observed occasionally.

LEPIDOPTERA

Skipper sp. A few seen. Possibly Dingy Grass-skipper *Toxidia peron*. **Caper White** *Belenois jaba*. Two seen on north island 28 March. **Cabbage White** *Pieris rapae*. Numerous and widespread across the whole island.

Common Brown *Heteronympha merope*. A few seen from the gulch between north and south island, along all main paths on the W side of south island to as far as the S end.

Meadow Argus *Junonia villida*. Appeared in large numbers on 28 March on south island.

Yellow Admiral *Vanessa itea*. One found at S end 27 March. Blue Tiger *Tirumala hamate*. Two seen on south island on 28 March. Long-tailed Pea-blue *Lampides boeticus*. Seen commonly, often on Coast Rosemary *Westringia fruticosa*.

A very small Lycaenid often seen but not identified.
