

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INTRODUCTION

It is a pleasure to introduce this thirty second edition of *Nature in Eurobodalla*, a report on the status of the fauna of the Eurobodalla Shire compiled from records submitted to the Eurobodalla Natural History Society during 2017. A map of the Shire is reproduced inside the front cover and a list of place name abbreviations used in the text appears inside the back cover.

The year 2017 was the warmest on record for New South Wales for both mean and daytime temperatures. It was also the State's driest year since 2006. Following the warmest summer on record for the State, heavy rain in March across the east then made way for a very dry winter and start to spring. Winter overnight temperatures were the lowest since 1997, but daytime temperatures remained above average for most of the year. Whilst new temperature records were set in the State there were no new records for the Shire.

Rainfall across the Eurobodalla was close to or below average, with the Bureau of Meteorology stations recording 844mm at Moruya Heads (88% of the average), 950mm at Narooma (103%) and 739 at Montagu Island (84%). March was especially wet, with 312mm at Maulbrooks Rd and 225 at Bergalia, whilst September was the driest month with zero recorded at Comerang and Lilli Pilli and 2mm at Mystery Bay and Coolagolite.

During the year members of the Society again participated in the NSW Parks and Wildlife shorebird monitoring programs and in BirdLife Australia surveys for Swift Parrot and Regent Honeyeater. No off-shore field trips were undertaken during the year and records of pelagic species are therefore primarily from land-based observations.

The year provided one new bird species for the Shire, a Common or Brown Noddy (*Anous stolidus*) photographed at Montagu Island on 26 March. Painted Honeyeater and Red-capped Robin were recorded for only the second time and there were sightings on 5 November of three species rarely recorded in the Shire - Turquoise Parrot, Spectacled Monarch and Satin Flycatcher - just to our north in Bimberamala National Park. There was also the first record of Eastern Osprey

breeding in the Shire, at Budd Is in the Clyde River, with one chick fledged in October. Five species of moth – Pink Leaf Moth, Vine Hawk Moth, Impatiens Hawk Moth, Soybean Looper and Oriental Tobacco Budworm – were also recorded in the Shire for the first time.

The absence of sightings can sometimes be as interesting as their presence and for the second year in a row the White-winged Triller was absent. Also absent from the records this year was the White-fronted Chat, whilst only ever reported from Tuross and never in large numbers this species has been sighted in most years since the Society began keeping records.

This report is restricted to those species recorded during the year; species not recorded are not listed. An annotated list of all bird species recorded in the Eurobodalla since the inception of the Society in 1986 is available on the Society's website (www.enhs.org.au) and is updated annually to reflect new sightings. As noted in previous years, the records reflect the distribution of observers and their interests as much as the distribution of the fauna. However, despite these shortcomings the records provide a valuable qualitative assessment of the status of species in the Shire, enabling trends over the years to be evaluated.

The vertebrate taxonomic sequence used basically follows Clayton *et al* (2006), with the listing of birds following the BirdLife Australia checklist based on Christides and Boles (2008). Taxonomic references used in compiling this report are listed below. The conservation status ascribed to bird species (Critically Endangered, Endangered and Vulnerable) is that given in Schedule 1 of the NSW Biodiversity Conservation Act, 2016.

Once again, my thanks go out to all contributors who have made this report possible. In particular I thank my co-complier, Julie Morgan, for her work as the Society's Recorder during the year. Thanks also to Chris Davey *et al* for the 59th Annual Assessment of Shearwater Breeding on Montagu Island. A complete list of those who have contributed their observations during the year appears on the final page.

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BIRDS

CASUARIIDAE Emu

Emu Dromaius novaehollandiae

Status: introduced in 1993, small wild population established.

Seven at Jemison's Pt in Apr; 4 at Brou L in Jan; 1 at DY in Aug and at

Bodalla in Sep; tracks at Bingie in Jan and at TS in Aug.

Breeding: 3 juveniles at Jemison's Pt in Apr. (FM)

PHASIANIDAE Quail, pheasants

Stubble Quail Coturnix pectoralis

Status: uncommon breeding resident.

Up to 20 at Com in Jan-May and Sep-Dec, up to 10 in other months. Breeding: dependent young at Com in Feb and Dec, juveniles in Dec. (JC)

Brown Quail Coturnix ypsilophora

Status: uncommon breeding resident.

Up to 44 at Montagu Is in Mar, 6 in May; 5 at Bingie Pt in Mar, 3 in Feb; 3 at Belowra in Mar; 2 at Com in Mar-Apr, 1 in Jun, calls in Jan-Feb.

ANATIDAE Swan, ducks

Musk Duck Biziura lobata

Status: uncommon breeding resident.

Two at Long Swamp in Oct; singles at PS in Jan and Cooper's Is in Sep. (MA/JM)

Freckled Duck Stictonetta naevosa

Status: vagrant.

Twelve at Trunketabella on 23 Jul. (JMG)

Black Swan Cygnus atratus

Status: common breeding resident and bird of passage.

Widely reported throughout the year; up to 360 at Jemison's Pt in Apr; 300 at Brou L in Jan; 150 at MHS in Mar; 130 at Bingie in Oct; 80 at Coila L in Feb; 40 at Long Swamp in Oct; no more than 20 at other locations.

Australian Shelduck Tadorna tadornoides

Status: vagrant.

One at Com in May and at Trunketabella in Dec. (JC/DB)

Australian Wood Duck Chenonetta jubata

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely reported throughout the year; 100 at Com in Jun-Aug, 30-80 in other months; 50 at Belowra in Jul; 40 at Eurobodalla Rd in Jun; 28 at DS in Aug; 26 at MB in Aug; 24 at Bergalia in Dec; no more than 20 at other locations.

Breeding: nesting in Aug, dependent young in May and Nov.

Pink-eared Duck Malacorhynchus membranaceus

Status: vagrant.

Up to 30 at Trunketabella in Jul; 2 at Broulee in Jan and 1 at Com in Jul. (HR/JC/JMG)

Australasian Shoveler *Anas rhynchotis*

Status: uncommon winter migrant, has bred.

Up to 30 at Trunketabella in Jul; 2-7 at Com in Jun-Aug; 4 at MYA in May and 1 at MO in Oct.

Grey Teal Anas gracilis

Status: breeding resident.

Reported throughout the year; 50 at Coila L in Feb; 40 at Com in May, 10-30 in other months; 26 at DS in Nov; 15 at Trunketabella in Oct and at Brou L in Nov; 12 at MYA in May; no more than 5 at other locations

Chestnut Teal Anas castanea

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely reported throughout the year; 300 at Brou L in Mar; 100 at Com in Aug, 20-80 most other months; 40 at DS in Oct; 32 at MYA in May; 20 at Coila L in Feb and at BB in Sep; fewer than 20 at other locations. Breeding: dependent young at Com in Feb. (JC)

Northern Mallard Anas platyrhynchos

Status: vagrant.

One at Com in Oct. (JC)

Pacific Black Duck Anas superciliosa

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely reported throughout the year; 200 at Com in Jul, 150 in Jun and Aug, 20-100 in other months; 40 at Coila L in Feb; 20 at MYA in May; fewer than 20 at other locations.

Breeding: dependent young at Com in Oct. (JC)

Hardhead Aythya australis

Status: common resident and bird of passage.

Thirty at Trunketabella in Jul, 3 in Oct; 7 at Com in Jul-Aug, 2 in Jun. (JC/JMG/MA)

PODICIPEDIDAE Grebes

Australasian Grebe Tachybaptus novaehollandiae

Status: common breeding resident.

Up to 10 at Com in Jul, 2-5 in other months; 8 at Bodalla in Sep; 6 at Bingie in Oct and at MB in Nov; 1-2 recorded at 8 other locations.

Hoary-headed Grebe Poliocephalus poliocephalus

Status: breeding resident.

Eight at Bingie in Oct-Nov; 6 at MO in Apr, 1 in Oct; 6 at Trunketabella in Jul; 5 at Belowra in Jan; 4 at Jemison's Pt in Apr; 1 at Com in May-Jun and at Brou L in Sep.

Breeding: dependent young at Belowra in Jan. (JC)

Great Crested Grebe *Podiceps cristatus*

Status: vagrant.

One at MO on 5 Apr. (NM)

COLUMBIDAE Pigeons, doves

Rock Dove Columba livia

Status: common breeding resident.

Established colonies at BB, MYA and NA; up to 30 at NA in Aug-Sep and Nov-Dec; 8 at Maloneys Beach in Oct. (MA/FM)

White-headed Pigeon Columba leucomela

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely recorded in all months; up to 20 at TS in Feb; 16 at MKS in Oct, 12 in Jan; 15 at Pedro in Feb, 12 in Jan; 9 at Lilli Pilli in Apr; 8 at Malua Bay in Nov; no more than 6 at other locations.

Spotted Dove *Streptopelia chinensis*

Status: breeding resident.

Five at MB in Jan, 4 in Jun; 4 at Maloneys Beach in Oct; 3 at DS in Oct-Nov; 2 at Broulee in Mar and Nov-Dec and at Com in Sep-Dec; 1 at Kianga in Feb.

Breeding: nesting at Com in Sep. (JC)

Brown Cuckoo-Dove Macropygia amboinensis

Status: uncommon breeding resident and bird of passage.

Up to 30 at MKS in Aug, 25 in Oct; 6 at Lilli Pilli in Jun and Oct; 2 at Malua Bay in Mar-Apr, Jul and Nov-Dec; 2 at DS in Jul; 1 at Coolagolite in Jan, at Com in Sep and at Maloneys Beach in Oct.

Emerald Dove Chalcophaps indica

Status: vagrant.

One adult and one juvenile seen on different days at the same location in Mogo SF in Apr. (JM)

Common Bronzewing Phaps chalcoptera

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely recorded in all months; up to 20 at MKS in Apr, 13 in Jul; 12 at Pedro in Mar, 10 in Feb; 6 at Com in Mar-May and Aug, at PS in May and Nov-Dec and at Bergalia in Dec; no more than 4 at other locations. Breeding: nesting at MKS in Oct. (SMG)

Brush Bronzewing Phaps elegans

Status: uncommon breeding resident.

Two at MKS in Apr; one at Bimberamala NP and Deua R in Nov.

Crested Pigeon Ocyphaps lophotes

Status: common breeding resident.

Recorded in all months; 30 at Eurobodalla Rd in Jun; 10 at Broulee in Jan; 9 at TS in May; 8 at Com in Mar-Apr; 6 at MB in Jun; no more than 5 at other locations.

Peaceful Dove Geopelia striata

Status: breeding resident but becoming less common.

Two at Com in Mar, 1 in Jun, calls in Jan-Feb and Jul-Sep. (JC)

Bar-shouldered Dove *Geopelia humeralis*

Status: uncommon resident.

Two at Surfside in Jan and at Montagu Is in Mar. (R Soroka/D Priddel)

Wonga Pigeon Leucosarcia picata

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely recorded in all months, 14 at Belowra Rd in Oct; 5 at Bodalla SF in May; 4 at MKS in Jan and Apr; no more than 3 at other locations.

Topknot Pigeon *Lopholaimus antarcticus*

Status: bird of passage.

Twenty three at MO in Oct, 3 in Jun; 10 at MKS in Oct, 8 in Jan-Feb and Nov; 7 at PS in Dec; 2 at Turlinjah in Jul; 1 at Broulee in Feb and at

NA in Oct.

PODARGIDAE Frogmouths

Tawny Frogmouth Podargus strigoides

Status: breeding resident.

Two at MB in Feb, 1 in Nov; 1 at Com in Feb and Apr; calls at MKS in Jan and Deua R in Oct and Dec.

EUROSTOPODIDAE Nightjars

White-throated Nightjar Eurostopodus mystacalis

Status: summer breeding migrant.

Up to 10 at PS in Jan and Dec, 2 in Nov, 1 in Mar; 1 at Deua R in Nov; calls at MKS in Oct.

AEGOTHELIDAE Owlet-nightjars

Australian Owlet-nightjar Aegotheles cristatus

Status: breeding resident.

One at Com in Jan-May and Sep-Oct, at MKS in Apr; calls at PS in Sep and Dec. (JC/JM/SMG)

APODIDAE Swifts

White-throated Needletail Hirundapus caudacutus

Status: summer migrant.

Reported in Jan-Mar and Nov-Dec; 50 at Com in Dec; 45 at MO in Feb; 40 at Bergalia and PS in Nov; 30 at BB, Malua Bay, PS and Com in Mar, at Brou L and Malua Bay in Dec; no more than 20 at other locations; last record at PS on 18 Mar, first return at Bergalia on 1 Nov.

DIOMEDEIDAE Albatrosses

Albatross sp

Ten off CO in May; 6 off Bogola Head in Jun; 3 off Mullimburra Pt in Aug.

Black-browed Albatross Thalassarche melanophris

Status: Vulnerable; common winter pelagic.

Eight off DS in Sep, 2 in Jul-Aug; 6 off MHS in Jul; 2 off Bogola Head in Jun.

Shy Albatross Thalassarche cauta

Status: Vulnerable; common winter pelagic. One dead at Long Beach on 9 Nov. (R Soroka)

PROCELLARIIDAE Petrels, shearwaters

Wedge-tailed Shearwater Ardenna pacifica

Status: common breeding resident and summer migrant.

Hundreds off MB in Oct; 1 at MO in Feb; 1 beachcast at MB in Feb and at DS in Nov.

Breeding: chicks at Montagu Is in Mar. (D Priddel)

Sooty Shearwater Ardenna grisea

Status: summer breeding migrant.

One chick at Montagu Is in Mar. (D Priddel)

Short-tailed Shearwater *Ardenna tenuirostris*

Status: common summer breeding migrant.

Hundreds off MO in Apr, 30 in Feb and 10 in Oct; 5 at BP in Oct.

(NM/NC)

Breeding: chicks at Montagu Is in Mar. (D Priddel)

Fluttering Shearwater Puffinus gavia

Status: common pelagic.

Up to 2000 off DS on 12 Aug; 50 off Mullimburra Pt in Aug; 1 off Bogola Head in Jun. (J Coffey/FM)

SPHENISCIDAE Penguins

Little Penguin Eudyptula minor

Status: common breeding resident.

Few seen at Montagu Is in Mar; 1 dead on beach at Broulee in Nov.

SULIDAE Gannets, boobies.

Australasian Gannet Morus serrator

Status: common winter migrant and bird of passage.

Forty off MO in Sep, 20 in Oct; 30 off DS in May and Sep; 24 off Bogola Head in Jun; 20 at Montagu Is in Mar; no more than 8 at other locations.

ANHINGIDAE Darter

Australasian Darter Anhinga novaehollandiae

Status: breeding resident.

Single birds at Com in Jan and Oct-Dec, at Bodalla in Sep, at BBWG, Bergalia and Brou L in Nov.

PHALACROCORACIDAE Cormorants

Little Pied Cormorant Microcarbo melanoleucos

Status: common breeding resident.

Reported in all months; 15 at Brou L in Nov, 12 in Mar; 8 at Broulee in Oct; 7 at CO in May; 6 at TS in Feb; no more than 5 at other locations.

Great Cormorant *Phalacrocorax carbo*

Status: common resident.

Reported in all months; 16 at Bogola Head in Jun; 15 at MO in Oct; 14 at Brou L in Jan; 12 at DS in Feb and at Com in Sep-Oct; 10 at MB in Jan; fewer than 10 at other locations.

Little Black Cormorant Phalacrocorax sulcirostris

Status: common resident.

Reported in all months; 120 at Brou L and DS in Aug; 20 at TS in Feb and at Broulee in Apr; no more than 5 at other locations.

Pied Cormorant Phalacrocorax varius

Status: uncommon resident.

Twelve at Broulee in Dec, 6 in Mar, 1 in Sep; 10 at Kianga in Sep; 9 at MO in Oct, 1 in Feb, Apr and Jun; 3 at Mullimburra Pt in Aug; 2 at DS in Oct; 1 at MB in Jan and Com in Dec.

PELECANIDAE Pelican

Australian Pelican Pelecanus conspicillatus

Status: common resident.

Widely reported in all months; 18 at Brou L in Jan and at TS in Sep; 12 at NA in Sep; 11 at DS in Aug; 10 at Coila L in Feb, at MYA in May and at MB in Nov; no more than 7 at other locations.

ARDEIDAE Bitterns, herons, egrets

White-necked Heron Ardea pacifica

Status: breeding resident.

Ten at Com in Jun, 1-5 most other months; 3 at MYA in Feb, at Bergalia in Oct and at Coolagolite in Nov; no more than 2 at other locations. Breeding: juvenile at Com in May. (JC)

Eastern Great Egret Ardea modesta

Status: common resident.

Sixteen at Trunketabella in Dec; 5 at DS in Oct, 4 in Aug; 3 at Broulee in Aug; no more than 2 at other locations.

Intermediate Egret Ardea intermedia

Status: uncommon migrant.

Three at MYA in Mar, 2 in Feb; 2 at Com in Jun, 1 in Apr-May and Jul-Nov; 2 at MHS in Aug; 1 at Brou L in Sep.

Cattle Egret Ardea ibis

Status: common autumn-spring migrant.

Recorded Apr-Nov; 34 at Com in Jun, 30 in Apr; 30 at MYA in Apr and Tilba in Sep; 20 at Cadgee in Aug; 18 at Bergalia in Aug; 12 at MB in Oct; fewer than 10 at other locations.

Striated Heron Butorides striata

Status: uncommon breeding resident.

Two at MYA in May and Mullimburra Pt in Jun; single birds at DS in May, NA in Sep and Broulee in Nov.

White-faced Heron Egretta novaehollandiae

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely reported in all months; 30 at Com in Jun and Dec, 4-25 in other months; 14 at MYA in May; 13 at Bingie in Feb; 12 at Brou L in Jan; 6 at NA in Sep; no more than 5 at other locations.

Little Egret Egretta garzetta

Status: common resident.

Twenty at Brou L in Nov, 6 in Mar, 2 in Jan; 2 at MB in Jan, 1 in Dec; 1 at TS in Feb.

Eastern Reef Egret Egretta sacra

Status: resident.

Two at Mullimburra Pt in Jan, 1 in Mar; 2 at Broulee in Jan, 1 in Mar-Apr and Jul; 2 at MO in Jun, 1 in Oct; 2 at MB in Jun-Nov, 1 in Dec; 1 at BI in Nov and at Bingie Pt in Dec.

Nankeen Night Heron Nycticorax caledonicus

Status: uncommon breeding resident.

Two at Gannon's Pt in May and at Com in Dec; 1 at BBWG in Feb.

THRESKIORNITHIDAE Ibises, spoonbills

Glossy Ibis Plegadis falcinellus

Status: vagrant.

Two at NA on 5 Mar and at Brou L on 10 Mar. (DHK/MC/PK)

Australian White Ibis Threskiornis molucca

Status: common resident and winter-spring migrant.

Seventy at MYA in May, 50 in Apr; 20 at Com in Apr, 9 in Nov; 12 at Broulee in Dec, 6 in Apr; 10 at Eurobodalla Rd in Jun; 7 at MB in Jul; no more than 5 at other locations.

Straw-necked Ibis Threskiornis spinicollis

Status: winter-spring migrant and bird of passage.

Up to 100 at MYA in May and Nov, 80 in Feb; 70 at Com in Apr, 60 in Aug; 40 at MO in Jun; 17 at Bergalia in Sep; no more than 2 at other locations.

Royal Spoonbill Platalea regia

Status: common resident.

Twelve at Trunketabella in Oct; 8 overflying Bergalia in Apr; 6 at Com in Jun and at NA in Jul; no more than 2 at other locations.

ACCIPITRIDAE Osprey, kites, eagles, harriers, goshawks

Eastern Osprey Pandion cristatus

Status: Vulnerable; uncommon migrant.

Three at BB in Oct, 2 in May-Jun, Aug-Sep and Dec; 1 at MHS in Jul and NA in Sep.

Breeding: nesting at BB in May-Oct, juvenile in Oct.

Black-shouldered Kite Elanus axillaris

Status: breeding resident.

Recorded in all months; 3 at MYA in Feb, 2 in May; 1 at Bergalia Jan-May and Nov-Dec, at MO in Feb, Apr and Oct, at Com in Mar-Sep, at MB in Feb and Nov-Dec.

Breeding: juvenile being fed at MYA in Feb. (JC/JM)

Square-tailed Kite Lophoictinia isura

Status: Vulnerable; uncommon spring-summer breeding migrant.

Two at PS in Dec, 1 in Sep; 1 at MKS and Broulee in Jan, at MB in Jan, Aug, Oct and Dec, at MHS in Aug and at SB in Dec.

White-bellied Sea-Eagle Haliaeetus leucogaster

Status: Vulnerable; common breeding resident.

Widely reported throughout the year; 6 at TS in Feb; 4 at DS in Feb and at MB in Aug-Sep; 3 at Pedro Pt in Jan, at MO in Feb and Montagu Is in Mar; no more than 2 at other locations.

Breeding: juveniles and immatures reported year round.

Whistling Kite Haliastur sphenurus

Status: breeding resident.

Reported in all months; 3 at Com in Jan-Mar and Sep-Nov; 3 at Jemison's Pt in Apr and at Bergalia in Nov; no more than 2 at other locations.

Breeding: nesting at Com in Jul-Aug, dependent young in Mar and Sep-Oct. (JC)

Brown Goshawk Accipiter fasciatus

Status: breeding resident.

Reported in all months; 1 at Com each month, at Bergalia in Jan-Feb and Sep-Nov, at MKS in Apr and Aug, at MO in Apr and Oct, at Trunketabella in May, at Bingie and MB in Jun and at Bodalla in Jul.

Collared Sparrowhawk Accipiter cirrocephalus

Status: breeding resident.

Two at TS in Feb; 1 at MO in Feb, at DS in Mar, at PS in Mar-Apr and Oct, at Mogo SF in Apr, at Com in Apr and Jul and at Coila Ck in Sep.

Grey Goshawk Accipiter novaehollandiae

Status: breeding resident, both grey and white morph occurring. Two at PS in Oct, 1 in Aug-Sep; 2 at Deua R in Dec, 1 in Nov; 1 at Bergalia in Jan, at Malua Bay in Mar and Sep-Oct, at Bingie Pt in Mar, at MO in Jun and Oct, at Mullimburra Pt in Aug and at Cullendulla Ck in Sep.

Spotted Harrier Circus assimilis

Status: Vulnerable; vagrant.

One at TS in May and at BB in Nov. (MA/DB)

Swamp Harrier Circus approximans

Status: breeding resident.

Single birds at Montagu Is in Mar, at MB in Jul, at Cooper's Is in Sep, at MO in Oct and at Illawong NR in Nov.

Wedge-tailed Eagle Aquila audax

Status: common breeding resident.

Reported in all months; 3 at PS in Jan-Feb and Dec, 2 in May; 3 at Coolagolite in Feb, 2 in Jan, Mar-Apr and Dec; 2 at Com most months, at MO in Feb and Jun, at MKS in Aug and Oct and at MB in Aug; single birds at 6 other locations during the year.

Breeding: juvenile at PS in Jan-Feb, May and Dec. (JM)

Little Eagle Hieraaetus morphnoides

Status: Vulnerable; uncommon breeding resident.

One at Kianga in May, at BB in Aug and at Cullendulla Ck in Oct.

FALCONIDAE Kestrel, hobby, falcons

Nankeen Kestrel Falco cenchroides

Status: common breeding resident.

Reported throughout the year; 6 at Com in Dec, 3 in Jan and Sep-Nov; 3 at MYA in May; 2 at Belowra and Coolagolite in Oct and at MB in Dec; single birds at 5 other locations during the year.

Breeding: nesting at Com in Nov, dependent young in Sep-Oct and Dec. (JC)

Brown Falcon Falco berigora

Status: breeding resident.

Reported throughout the year; 2 at Com each month; 1 at Jemison's Pt in Apr, at Eurobodalla Rd in Jun, at Belowra in Jul, at Bumbo in Aug and at MB in Sep and Nov.

Australian Hobby Falco longipennis

59th ANNUAL ASSESSMENT OF SHEARWATER BREEDING SUCCESS ON MONTAGU ISLAND, 15–20 MARCH 2018

The format of this report and the abbreviations used are consistent with those in previous annual reports (e.g. Priddel *et al.* 2017). Montagu Island is divided into two parts by a steep gulch and a beach that is passable at all tides. We refer to these two portions as north island and south island. Replanting of the south island with taller vegetation, using plants known to have been on the island in the past, has occurred following systematic control of Kikuyu Grass *Pennisetum clandestinum*. This has been done progressively over the last 16 years across designated zones, and these zones (numbered 1–9 or assigned as Asset A, B or C and Accidental) are used in this report for reference purposes. They are briefly described (condition in March 2013) and shown in a map in Fullagar *et al.* (2012).

Our shearwater colony study site on the SE side of the smaller northern part of Montagu Island (zone 9) is known as NISA (293 m²); the two study sites at N end of the southern part are known as SISA (428 m²) and THiSA (293 m²) and are located at the N end of zone 8. The location of these study sites is shown in Fullagar and Heyligers (2006). In addition to assessing the breeding success of shearwaters annually, the vegetation is also mapped for each site. A grid of 1 x 1 ft cells (set up in 1967 before metrication) is laid over each study site. For NISA and THiSA the area is divided into 60×54 cells, and for SISA 72×66 cells. The occurrence of each plant species within a study site is calculated as the proportion of cells in which that species occurs.

The bird records for the island have been reviewed by Fullagar (1989) but many subsequent records have been included in annual reports (similar to this one) dating back to 1998. We have decided for this report, and in future, to use the names and taxonomic order of birds following the latest available version of the IOC World Bird List (Gill and Donsker 2018); all other vertebrates follow Clayton *et al.* (2006). However, we have also adopted the common name Long-nosed Fur Seal in place of the inappropriate name New Zealand Fur Seal, following the recommendation by Shaughnessy and Goldsworthy (2015). Names of butterflies follow Braby (2004), moths follow Common (1990) while

those of vascular plants follow those used by Heyligers and Adams (1989, 2004).

Survey Team

This year's team comprised Peter Fullagar, Mike Crowley, Chris Davey and David Priddel (MIPartners); Penny Beaver, Phil Kingston, Vanessa Place, Lesley Priddel and Chloe Spear.

Weather and Habitat Conditions

We departed Narooma at 9:30 on 15 March, crossing the bar in easy conditions on a high tide. Pleasant conditions continued all day with light breeze from the SE. The following day was fine with a light S wind. On 17 March light rain early in the morning delayed our start until 11:45 by which time warm conditions had dried the vegetation and the afternoon was a hot 30°C. On 18 March the weather was hot with a strong N to NW strong wind to 30 knots and a temperature of 35°C. A strong southerly change with gusts of up to 27 knots late in the afternoon saw the temperature drop to 22°C. The following day saw mild weather with little or no wind or swell. An approaching weather front caused concern and required an early departure on 20 March.

Monthly rainfall figures (mm) from April 2017 to March 2018 are as follows: 66.8, 94.6, 23.6, 26.4, 27.0, 0.4, 86.0, 75.4, 111.8, 56.4, 117.4, and 12.0 up to 20 March.

Conditions have been good this summer with regular rainfall throughout. On all study sites the Spiny-headed Mat-rush *Lomandra longifolia* was lush and dense. Scarlet Runner *Kennedia rubicunda* is now well established on NISA and SISA.

Kikuyu Grass continues to spread throughout the island although recent control has almost eliminated it from SISA.

Coverage

We started work on THiSA at 13:00 on 15 March, finishing at 16:25. On 16 March we completed NISA between 08:50 and finished at 15:10. We started SISA on 17 March at 11:45 and worked until lunch (13:00–14:20) and was completed at 18:05. On 18 March we made casual observations on the south island. On 19 March we systematically surveyed the South Island from 8:00 until 1230. PJF, DP and MC covered the area from kitchen gardens to the south landing. CCD and PK covered the eastern side of south island as well as the very southern end.

In the afternoon we entered and analysed records and drafted the report. An intended bird and seal survey of the north island on 20 March was not possible as an approaching front forced an early departure from the island.

Survey Results 1. Shearwaters

The results of this year's survey, together with those for 2017, are summarised in Table 1.

As Table 1 shows, burrow numbers were almost identical to those in 2017, and the overall percentage of occupied burrows was lower (42%). The average weight of Wedge-tailed Shearwater chicks this season was 300 g (137–480 g); the comparable figure for Short-tailed Shearwater was 593 g (292–925 g). Average weights of Wedge-tailed Shearwater chicks in 2017 were 417 g and 627 g for Short-tailed Shearwater. These average weights are not comparable with those of 2017 because they were taken nine days earlier.

Wedge-tailed Shearwater comprised 77% on NISA, 38% on THiSA and 42% on SISA, giving an overall figure of 54%, continuing the steady increase in breeding success of Wedge-tailed Shearwater at the expense of Short-tailed Shearwater on the island. NISA continues to be a study

area heavily dominated by Wedge-tailed Shearwater. No Sooty Shearwater chicks were found.

2. Penguins

No landing site surveys were conducted and no birds were seen or heard ashore at night.

General Observations of Birds, Mammals, Reptiles and Lepidoptera BIRDS

Thirty-seven species were recorded this year and eight eBird lists were submitted.

Brown Quail *Coturnix ypsilophora*. Heard or seen in low numbers on all days with a maximum of 12 in 19 March. Fewer than last year.

Little Penguin Eduptula minor. None seen ashore.

White-faced Storm-Petrel *Pelagodroma marina*. Eight geolocators from those fitted to 19 birds in January 2016 were recovered from five targeted surveys between September 2017 and January 2018. Data are currently being analysed. Banding efforts during this period found more than 330 individuals over the colony, far in excess of what was expected. A second year of intensive studies will follow in 2018–19.

Black-browed Albatross *Thalassarche melanophris*. One with many Shy Albatross ahead of strong southerly front on 18 March.

Shy Albatross *Thalassarche* cauta. Fifty-nine counted in 40 minutes in association with strong southerly front on 18 March.

Gould's Petrel *Pterodroma leucoptera*. Targeted surveys between October 2017 and March 2018 have found the areas used for breeding by this species have consolidated with nesting densities increasing at all sites.

Wedge-tailed Shearwater Ardenna pacifica and Short-tailed Shearwater Ardenna tenuirostris. See Table 1 for this year's chick count. Both species seen in low numbers at sea on all days.

White-faced Heron *Egretta novaehollandiae*. Two on east side of south island on 19 March.

Australasian Gannet *Morus serrator*. Observed in low numbers on all days; mostly juveniles.

Little Pied Cormorant *Microcarbo melanoleucos*. Two seen on eastern side of south island on 19 March.

Great Cormorant *Phalacrocorax carbo*. Seen on all days with a maximum of 12 on 19 March.

Swamp Harrier *Circus approximans*. One dark-plumaged bird, presumably a juvenile seen on 19 March.

White-bellied Sea-Eagle *Haliaeetus leucogaster*. Maximum three. One adult in advanced moult on 19 and 20 March. Another adult and a juvenile recorded on 20 March.

Buff-banded Rail *Gallirallus philippenis*. Few birds seen and heard. Maximum of four on 19 March.

Sooty Oystercatcher *Haematopus fuliginous*. Seven birds seen on Island.

Silver Gull *Chroicocephalus novaehollandiae*. Seen every day in low numbers. A late fledging chick seen with parents at north landing and two flying juveniles with adults at south landing on 19 March.

Pacific Gull *Larus pacificus*. Two juveniles seen flying between north and south island on 15 March. First record since 1993.

Caspian Tern *Hydroprogne caspia*. Seen on all days with a maximum of nine, including one juvenile on 17 March.

Greater Crested Tern *Thalasseus bergii*. Observed in low numbers on all days.

Jaeger *Stercorarius* sp One seen on the crossing from Narooma to the island on 15 March.

Bar-shouldered Dove *Geopelia humeralis*. Two seen on 18 and 19 March.

Bronze Cuckoo *Chalcites* sp. One flying over study area on 15 March. **Fan-tailed Cuckoo** *Cacomantis flabelliformis*. One first-year bird found dead near light station on 15 March.

White-throated Needletail *Hirundapus caudacutus*. Seen on all days hawking over the island. Maximum of 20 on 17 March.

Sacred Kingfisher Todiramphus sanctus. One seen on 19 March.

Peregrine Falcon *Falco peregrinus*. One bird seen on all days.

Crimson Rosella *Platycercus elegans*. A juvenile seen on two occasions on 19 March. A new record for the island.

Eastern Spinebill *Acanthorhynchus tenuirostris*. One adult seen in thickets on western side of the island on 19 March. Second record for the island.

Yellow-faced Honeyeater *Lichenostomus chrysops*. Numerous in the thickets on the western side of the island. Seen or heard and all days. **Black-faced Cuckooshrike** *Corcina novaehollandiae*. One on 19 March in thickets on the western side of the island.

Australian Golden Whistler *Pachycephala pectoralis*. One female seen and heard in thickets on western side of the island on 19 March.

Grey Fantail *Rhipidura albiscapa*. One juvenile seen in thickets on western side of the island on 19 March.

Rufous Fantail *Rhipidura rufifrons*. One seen on 15 and 19 March. **Welcome Swallow** *Hirundo neoxena*. Seen daily. Minimum numbers estimated at 15.

Little Grassbird *Megalurus gramineus*. Inconspicuous at this time of year, few seen.

Golden-headed Cisticola *Cisticola exilis*. Not vocal and difficult to detect, but a few seen on some days.

Silvereye *Zosterops lateralis*. Present on all days, mostly in the thickets along the W side of south island. Small flocks observed but numbers difficult to assess. Maximum of 20 recorded on 17 March.

MAMMALS

Seals. A count on 15 March from the *Shearwater* vessel prior to landing gave an approximate estimate of 60 Australia Fur Seal, *Arctocephalus pusillus* and 70 Long-nosed (New Zealand) Fur Seal, *A. forsteri*. Six pups of various ages were noted, some very small and still suckling and others quite large. Several also observed far from the waterline in dense Kikuyu Grass and not included in the count. Fifteen Long-nosed Fur Seal were seen on rocks at the south landing on 19 March with an additional five further south. No counts were made from north island.

REPTILES

White's Skink *Ergenia whitii*. Observed occasionally. Grass Sun-skink *Lampropholis guichenoti*. Observed occasionally.

LEPIDOPTERA

Cabbage White *Pieris rapae*. Quite common across south island. Common Brown *Heteronympha merope*. One noted on 15 March. Spotted Jezabel *Delias aganippe*. One feeding on Westringia on 19 March.

Orchid Swallowtail *Papilio Aegeus*. One male seen on SISA on 17 March.

Painted Lady Vanessa kershawi. One seen on 17 March.

Meadow Argus *Junonia villida*. Two seen on 20 March near thickets on south island.

Yellow Admiral *Vanessa itea*. One seen on 19 March; one at S end of south island.

Dingy Grass Brown Toxida peron.

Heliotrope Moth Utetheisa pulchelloides.
