

# **INTRODUCTION**

It is a pleasure to introduce this thirty fourth edition of *Nature in Eurobodalla*, a report on the status of the fauna of the Eurobodalla Shire compiled from records submitted to the Eurobodalla Natural History Society during 2019. A map of the Shire is reproduced inside the front cover and a list of place name abbreviations used in the text appears inside the back cover.

The year 2019 was the warmest on record for New South Wales, with a mean temperature 1.95 °C above average. Minimum temperatures for the year overall were very warm with Narooma recording its highest ever daily minimum temperature on 16 January. The year was also dominated by very dry conditions, with total rainfall the State 55% below average. Rainfall across the Eurobodalla was well below average, with the Bureau of Meteorology stations recording 513mm at Moruya Heads (54% of the average), 583mm at Narooma (64%) and 473mm at Montagu Island (54%). March was the wettest month with 92mm at Lilli Pilli, 95mm at Coolagolite, 136 at Bergalia and 140mm at Comerang. August and December were particularly dry with only 0.5mm at Coolagolite and 1mm at Bergalia and Maulbrooks Rd in August and 1mm at Lilli Pilli in December. The dry, warm weather, combined with low humidity and strong winds, saw a prolonged period of bushfire activity with large and severe fires from October onward causing extensive damage and persistent smoke throughout the Shire.

The year provided records of two new bird species for the Shire, a Lesser Frigatebird (*Fregata ariel*) recorded at Montagu Is in March and a South Island Pied Oystercatcher (*Haematopus finschi*) photographed at Coila Lake in September. The sighting of a Euro (*Macropus robustus*) at Mystery Bay in August was also the first record of this species in the Shire and two invertebrates, the Minute Two-spotted Ladybird (*Diomus notescens*) and the Magnificent Spider (*Ordgarius magnificus*) were recorded for the first time.

Two other species were recorded for only the second time, a Greyheaded Albatross *(Thalassarche chrysostoma)* off Moruya Heads in June and a pair of Turquoise Parrot *(Neophema pulchella)* at Pedro Swamp in September. Other noteworthy sightings were of two Platypus *(Ornithorhynchus anatinus)* in the Deua River in September and a Common Dunnart *(Sminthopsis murina)* at Broulee in January. The extension in the range of the Yellow-bellied Glider *(Petaurus australis)* south of the Moruya River was also confirmed with a sighting at Pedro Swamp in June.

Missing from the list this year is the European Goldfinch, the first time this has occurred since 2000. Also, for the first time in a decade, there were no sightings of the Australian Shelduck. However, the Whitewinged Triller returned after a three year absence.

During the year members of the Society again participated in the NSW Parks and Wildlife shorebird monitoring programs and in BirdLife Australia surveys for Swift Parrot and Regent Honeyeater. No off-shore field trips were undertaken during the year and records of pelagic species are therefore primarily from land-based observations.

This report is restricted to those species recorded during the year; species not recorded are not listed. An annotated list of all bird species recorded in the Eurobodalla since the inception of the Society in 1986 is available on the Society's website (www.enhs.org.au) and is updated annually to reflect new sightings. As noted in previous years, the records reflect the distribution of observers and their interests as much as the distribution of the fauna. However, despite these shortcomings the records provide a valuable qualitative assessment of the status of species in the Shire, enabling trends over the years to be evaluated.

The taxonomic sequence in which the bird species are listed has been changed this year to follow the Birdlife Australia Working List of Australian Birds v3 published in August 2019. The taxonomic sequence used for other vertebrate species basically follows Clayton *et al* (2006). Taxonomic references used in compiling this report are listed below. The conservation status ascribed to bird species (Critically Endangered, Endangered and Vulnerable) is that given in Schedule 1 of the NSW Biodiversity Conservation Act, 2016.

Regular readers will notice that there is no report on Shearwater Breeding Success at Montagu Island in this edition. For the first time in 60 years, the survey were not conducted, because of restrictions associated with COVID-19.

Once again, my thanks go out to all contributors who have made this report possible. I particularly thank my co-complier, Julie Morgan, for her work as the Society's Recorder during the year. A complete list of those who have contributed their observations during the year appears on the final page.

## BIRDS

CASUARIIDAE Emu.

**Emu** *Dromaius novaehollandiae* Status: introduced in 1993, small wild population established. One reported at Nerrigundah on 11 Sep. (JC)

PHASIANIDAE Quail, pheasants.Stubble Quail Coturnix pectoralisStatus: uncommon breeding resident.Up to 20 at Com in Jan-Apr, up to 10 in other months. (JC)

**Brown Quail** Synoicus ypsilophorus Status: uncommon breeding resident. Up to 25 at Montagu Is in Mar, 10 in Jul and 1 in Dec; 2 at Com in Jan and at MYA in May.

ANATIDAE Swans, geese, ducks. Musk Duck *Biziura lobata* Status: uncommon breeding resident. Twenty-six at Lake Tarourga on 14 Sep; 2 at Tilba L on 2 May. (FM/MA)

#### Freckled Duck Stictonetta naevosa

Status: Vulnerable; vagrant. Up to 100 at Newstead Pond, MHS in Apr-May, 28 in Jul and 15 in Aug; 1 at BBWG in Dec.

#### Black Swan Cygnus atratus

Status: common breeding resident and bird of passage.

Widely reported throughout the year; up to 300 at TS in Feb-Mar; 280 at Coila L in Mar; 200 at MHS in May, 80 in Feb; 150 at MB in May; 80 at Bingie in Jan; 72 at Lake Tarourga in Sep; 50 at Brou L in Nov; fewer than 40 at other locations.

Breeding: cygnets at Deua R in Sep. (A Cram)

## Australian Wood Duck Chenonetta jubata

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely reported throughout the year; up to 60 at Com in Jul, 20-50 most other months; 49 at DS in Apr; 40 at MYA in Apr, at BBWG in Dec; 35 at Bergalia in Feb; 26 at Belowra in Oct; 25 at Bumbo Rd in Apr; fewer than 20 at other locations.

Breeding: dependent young in Feb, Sep and Nov. (DHK/NM)

#### Hardhead Aythya australis

Status: common resident and bird of passage. Ten at Coila L in Mar; 4 at BBWG in Oct; singles at Com in Mar and Jul and at MO in Aug.

#### Australasian Shoveler Spatula rhynchotis

Status: uncommon winter migrant, has bred.

Thirty-seven at Bevian Rd in May; 5 at MYA in Apr; 5 at Com in Jun, 2 in Jul and 1 in Mar. (DB/JC)

## Pacific Black Duck Anas superciliosa

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely reported throughout the year; 300 at Com in Apr, 50-100 most other months; 40 at Bumbo Rd in Apr; 20 at MYA in Apr, at BBWG in Nov-Dec; 15 at Broulee in Jun; 12 at MO in Jan and Nov; no more than 10 at other locations.

Breeding: dependent young at Com in Oct. (JC)

#### Grey Teal Anas gracilis

Status: breeding resident.

Reported throughout the year; 40 at MYA in Feb; 30 at Com in May-Jul, 10-20 most other months; 23 at DS in Jul and Sep; 20 at NA in Oct, at MO in Nov and at BBWG in Dec; no more than 15 at other locations.

#### Chestnut Teal Anas castanea

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely reported throughout the year; 100 at Coila L in Dec, 60 in Mar; 75 at Bingie in Nov; 50 at Com in Feb and Sep-Dec, at TS in Mar and at MO in Aug; 45 at MYA in Feb; 40 at DS in Oct; no more than 10 at other locations.

## PODICIPEDIDAE Grebes.

# Australasian Grebe Tachybaptus novaehollandiae

Status: common breeding resident.

Four at MB in May and at Lake Tarourga in Sep; 3 at MO in Aug and Oct; 2 at Brou L in Nov and at Kianga in Dec; 1 at Bergalia in Apr, at Com in May-Jul and at DS in Sep.

## Hoary-headed Grebe Poliocephalus poliocephalus

Status: breeding resident.

Eleven at Bingie in Apr, 8 in Sep and 4 in Oct; 5 at MO in Aug and Oct-Nov; 1 at DS in Jul.

#### **COLUMBIDAE** Pigeons, doves.

#### Rock Dove Columba livia

Status: common breeding resident.

Established colonies at BB, MYA and NA; up to 50 at MYA in Dec; 40 at NA in Aug and Nov; 35 at MB in Dec; 4 at TS in Sep.

#### White-headed Pigeon Columba leucomela

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely recorded in all months; up to 20 at TS in Feb-Mar and Sep and at MHS in Oct; 9 at Coila L in Mar and at Lilli Pilli in Jun; 7 at MKS in Dec; 6 at MB in May and Aug; no more than 4 at other locations. Breeding: juveniles at Broulee in Dec. (GLM)

#### Spotted Dove Spilopelia chinensis

Status: breeding resident. Recorded in all months; up to 4 at DS in Jan and at MB in May, Aug and Oct; 1-2 regularly at Broulee, Com and MYA.

#### Brown Cuckoo-Dove Macropygia phasianella

Status: uncommon breeding resident and bird of passage. Up to 40 at MKS in Sep, 25 in Aug; 9 at NA in Oct; 6 at Lilli Pilli in Oct; 2 at DS in Mar and at Malua Bay in Jun and Aug; 1 at Coolagolite in Aug and Nov and at MO in Nov.

#### Wonga Pigeon Leucosarcia melaoleuca

Status: common breeding resident.

Four at MB in Feb, May and Aug; 3 at MKS in Jan-Feb and at Coolagolite in Mar and Oct; 2 at Lilli Pilli in Sep; 1 or calls at other locations

#### Common Bronzewing Phaps chalcoptera

Status: common breeding resident.

Widely recorded in all months; up to 20 at MKS in Feb and Apr, 16 in Jan; 13 at Com in Nov; 8 at MYA in Dec; 6 at Bergalia in Jan-Feb and Dec; no more than 5 at other locations.

#### **Crested Pigeon** Ocyphaps lophotes

Status: common breeding resident.

Recorded in all months; 20 at Com in Apr, 6-10 most other months; 12 at MYA in May; 10 at DS in Apr; 8 at TS in Mar and at Broulee in Jun; no more than 5 at other locations.

Breeding: Dependent young at Com in Sep. (JC)

#### Peaceful Dove Geopelia striata

Status: breeding resident but becoming less common. Four at MB in May; 3 at Com in Oct-Nov, 2 in Dec. (MA/JC)

#### Bar-shouldered Dove Geopelia humeralis

Status: uncommon resident. Six at Coila L in Sep; 2 at BP in Mar and at Montagu Is in Jul; 1 at TS in Sep. (DB/JM/GM)

#### Topknot Pigeon Lopholaimus antarcticus

Status: bird of passage. Up to 35 at PS in Oct, 12 in Dec; 21 at MO in Oct, 5 in Feb and 3 in Dec; 20 at MYA in Oct; 18 at Brou L in Nov; 12 at MHS and Bengello Beach in Oct.

#### **PODARGIDAE** Frogmouths.

#### Tawny Frogmouth Podargus strigoides

Status: breeding resident. Two at MO in Jan and Aug, 1 in Oct; 2 at Com in Apr; 1 at MHS in Mar, at MKS in Sep and at Bergalia in Nov.

#### EUROSTOPODIDAE Eared Nightjars.

White-throated Nightjar Eurostopodus mystacalis

Status: summer breeding migrant.

Five at PS in Feb, 2 in Jan and Sep, 1 in Oct; 1 at Surfside in Jan and Mar and at MYA in Feb; calls at Wamban in Oct-Nov.

AEGOTHELIDAE Owlet-nightjars.

Australian Owlet-nightjar *Aegotheles cristatus* Status: breeding resident. One at Com in Apr; call at MB in May. (JC/MA)

#### **APODIDAE** Swifts.

#### White-throated Needletail Hirundapus caudacutus

Status: summer migrant.

Reported in Jan-Mar and Oct-Dec; 100 at PS in Jan, 50 in Nov; 40 at Com in Jan; 8 at Deua R in Jan; 6 at MO in Feb, 3 in Dec; 3 at Wamban in Oct; 1 at DS in Mar; last record at DS on 15 Mar, first return at Wamban on 28 Oct.

### Fork-tailed Swift Apus pacificus

Status: uncommon summer migrant.

Thirty at MO in Jan, 5 in Nov; 10 at PS in Jan; reported at Surfside and TS in Jan.

#### CUCULACIDAE Cuckoos.

#### Eastern Koel Eudynamys orientalis

Status: summer breeding migrant.

Reported Jan-Feb and Sep-Dec; 6 at Broulee in Jan-Feb, 4 in Oct and Dec; 2 at DS in Jan and Oct, at Com in Jan and Nov-Dec, at Bergalia in Oct, at MO in Nov and at BBWG in Dec; 1 or calls at other locations; last record at Broulee and MKS on 15 Feb, first return at SB on 26 Sep. Breeding: young at Broulee in Jan-Feb, at Com in Feb and at DS in Oct.

## Channel-billed Cuckoo Scythrops novaehollandiae

Status: summer breeding migrant.

Reported Jan-Feb and Sep-Dec; 4 at MB in Jan; 3 at Com in Nov, 2 in Jan; 2 at MYA in Sep and at Bergalia in Oct-Nov; 1 or calls at other locations; last record at Bergalia in Feb, first return at MKS on 22 Sep. Breeding: dependent young at PS in Jan and Dec being fed by Pied Currawong. (JM)

## Horsfield's Bronze-Cuckoo Chalcites basalis

Status: summer breeding migrant.

One at Com and Deua R in Jan and at MO in Aug and Nov; calls at PS in Mar and Oct-Nov.

## Shining Bronze-Cuckoo Chalcites lucidus

Status: summer breeding migrant and bird of passage. Two at MO in Nov, 1 in Aug, Oct and Dec; 1 at Com in Jan-Feb, Apr and Oct-Nov, at Bergalia in Sep and at Brou L in Oct; calls at MKS in Sep, at PS in Sep-Dec and at Wadbilliga in Oct.

## Fan-tailed Cuckoo Cacomantis flabelliformis

Status: common breeding resident.

Recorded in all months; 3 at MO in Aug, 2 in Nov; 2 at DS in Aug, at Malua Bay in Sep, at Brou L and Wadbilliga in Oct and at PS in Dec; all other records of 1 or calls.

## Brush Cuckoo Cacomantis variolosus

Status: summer breeding migrant. Four at PS in Nov, calls in Oct and Dec; 2 at MO in Oct, 1 in Nov-Dec; 1 at DS in Mar; calls at MKS and Deua R in Jan.

### Pallid Cuckoo Heteroscenes pallidus

Status: summer-breeding migrant. Two at Com in Oct-Nov, 1 in Dec; 2 at Belowra in Oct; call at Bergalia in Nov.

# **RALLIDAE** Rails, Crakes, swamphens. **Buff-banded Rail** *Hypotaenidia philippensis*

Status: rare breeding resident. Four at Montagu Is in Mar, 2 in Jul; 2 at Com in Mar-Apr, 1 in May; 1 at MYA in Sep and at BBWG in Dec; calls at TS in Jan.

#### Australian Spotted Crake *Porzana fluminea* Status: rare resident. One at BBWG on 7-8 Dec. (JM/NC)

## Baillon's Crake Zapornia pusilla

Status: vagrant. One at BBWG on Sep and Dec. (DB)

#### Spotless Crake Zapornia tabuensis

Status: rare resident. Two at BBWG in Dec, 1 in Nov; 1 at Bevian Rd in May-Jun. (JF/JM/NC)

#### Purple Swamphen Porphyrio porphyrio

Status: common breeding resident. Recorded throughout the year; 40 at BBWG in Dec, 15 in Nov; 27 at Bergalia in Sep, 16 in Dec; 15 at MB in Mar and Jul-Aug; 14 at Com in Apr; fewer than 10 at other locations. Breeding: dependent young in Jan-Feb and Oct-Nov, juveniles in Mar.

#### **Dusky Moorhen** *Gallinula tenebrosa* Status: uncommon breeding resident. Three at BBWG in Dec, 2 in Nov; 1 at NA in Oct. Breeding: dependent young at BBWG in Nov. (JF)

#### **Eurasian Coot** *Fulica atra*

Status: common breeding resident. Up to 130 at Bingie in Jun, 110 in Apr; 50 at Kianga in Dec; 40 at BBWG in Dec; 35 at NA in Oct; 30 at Bumbo Rd in Apr; no more than 10 at other locations. SPHENISCIDAE Penguins. Little Penguin *Eudyptula minor* Status: common breeding resident. Two found dead on beach at MHS in Feb; 1 heard at Montagu Is in Jul. (DB/JM/MC)

**OCEANITIDAE** Southern Storm-Petrels **White-faced Storm-Petrel** *Pelagodroma marina* Status: summer migrant breeding on Montagu Is. One reported off Mullimburra Pt on 31 Jan. (NM)

# DIOMEDEIDAE Albatrosses

Albatross sp. Four off Burrawang in Aug; 1 off Bogola Head in Jun. (FM)

#### Indian Yellow-nosed Albatross Thalassarche carteri

Status: regularly recorded off the coast. Two off BI in Jul; 1 off MHS in Jun and Aug and off NA in Jul. (MC/DB)

#### Grey-headed Albatross Thalassarche chrysostoma

Status: vagrant. One reported off MHS on 22 Jun, the second record for the Shire. (DB)

**Black-browed Albatross** *Thalassarche melanophris* Status: Vulnerable; common winter pelagic. Twenty off MHS in Jun, 5 in Aug and 1 in Jul. (DB/JM/FM)

**Shy Albatross** *Thalassarche cauta* Status: Vulnerable; common winter pelagic. Up to 450 off MHS on 22 Aug; 10 in Jun and 2 in Jul; reported off Montagu Is in Mar.

Salvin's Albatross *Thalassarche salvini* Status: occasionally recorded off the coast. One recorded off MHS on 22 Aug. (DB)

**PROCELLARIIDAE** Petrels, shearwaters. **Northern Giant-Petrel** *Macronectes halli* Status: Vulnerable; occasionally recorded in coastal waters. One recorded off MHS on 22 Aug. (DB)

## Prion sp.

Reported in large numbers off MHS on 22 Aug and off BP in Jul and Aug.

**Fairy Prion** *Pachyptila turtur* Status: Regularly recorded off the coast. Six off BI and 1 off NA in Jul. (MC)

**Gould's Petrel** *Pterodroma leucoptera* Status: Vulnerable; summer breeding migrant. Chicks reported at Montagu Is in Jan. (N Carlisle)

## Shearwater sp.

Thousands migrating south off Bingie Pt, CO, MB, MHS and MO in Oct; many beachcast at MHS in Nov.

# Wedge-tailed Shearwater Ardenna pacifica

Status: common breeding resident and summer migrant. Up to 500 off MO in Aug; 200 off MHS in Feb; 12 at MB in Feb; 10 found dead at DS in Nov, 3 in Jan; few beachcast at MB in Nov; reported from Montagu Is in Mar. Breeding: chicks at Montagu Is in Mar. (P Fullagar)

# Short-tailed Shearwater Ardenna tenuirostris

Status: common summer breeding migrant. Eighty off MO in Jan, 10 in Dec; 50 off MHS in Feb; 2 found dead at DS in Oct; reported from Montagu Is in Mar and Dec. Breeding: chicks at Montagu Is in Mar. (P Fullagar)

# Sooty Shearwater Ardenna grisea

Status: summer breeding migrant. One chick at Montagu Is in Mar. (P Fullagar)

# Fluttering Shearwater Puffinus gavia

Status: common pelagic. Large flocks, up to 2000, reported off BP in Jul-Aug and MHS in Aug; 5 off MHS in Feb; 2 off Montagu Is in Dec; 1 beachcast at MHS in Feb.

# THRESKIORNITHIDAE Ibis, spoonbills.

## Royal Spoonbill Platalea regia

Status: common resident.

Up to 40 at Bumbo Rd in Feb; 30 at Trunketabella in Jan; 15 at NA in Aug; 12 at MB in May; 7 at DY in Dec; 6 at Broulee in Jun; no more

than 4 at other locations. Breeding: dependent young at BBWG in Dec. (DB)

#### Straw-necked Ibis Threskiornis spinicollis

Status: winter-spring migrant and bird of passage. Up to 300 at MB in Apr, 150 in May; 200 at Com in Feb and Apr-Jun and at MYA in Feb-Apr; 170 at Mogendoura in Sep; 150 at Bogola Head in Jun; 40 at Eurobodalla Rd in Oct; no more than 15 at other locations.

#### Australian White Ibis Threskiornis moluccus

Status: common resident and winter-spring migrant. Up to 100 at MYA in Mar, 50 in Jan; 40 at BBWG in Dec, 10 in Nov; 35 at Com in Feb, 11 in Mar; 12 at MB in May; 10 at Bergalia in Jun; fewer than 10 at other locations.

**Glossy Ibis** *Plegadis falcinellus* Status: vagrant. One reported at Coila L on 16 Nov. (P Gatenby)

ARDEIDAE Bitterns, herons, egrets. Australian Little Bittern *Ixobrychus dubius* Status: rarely recorded. Three at BBWG on 8 Dec, 1 on four other days from 4-15 Dec. (DB/JM/NC)

#### Nankeen Night Heron Nycticorax caledonicus

Status: uncommon breeding resident. Up to 7 at BBWG in Dec, 1 in Jan and Sep; 1 at DS in Feb and at MO in Nov.

#### Striated Heron Butorides striata

Status: uncommon breeding resident. Two at NA in Mar, 1 in Oct-Nov; 1 at Tomakin in Jun. (MA/FM/V Brown)

#### Cattle Egret Bubulcus ibis

Status: common autumn-spring migrant.

Sixty at MYA in Apr; 40 at MB in Nov; 16 at Broulee in Apr; 15 at Com in Jun; 8 at Bergalia in Jun and at DS in Oct; no more than 2 at other locations.
